Please take this list of needed supplies to the store with you. ☺ Be sure to label lunch boxes and backpacks with your child's name. It helps us tremendously. Please avoid patterns with monsters or scary things.

### Kindergarten

[Mrs. Solodon will be purchasing the markers, pencils, etc., so that all students have identical supplies. This eliminates unnecessary distractions and delays. If you would like to donate \$10 cash to help defray that cost, it would be appreciated.]

Folder with two bottom pockets (important that it does not have side pockets, because many papers are larger)

Backpack (large enough to fit folder and lunch box) with name on it

Small lunch box for snack and drink with name on outside

One container (or more) of antibacterial wipes

One large box of Kleenex to share with the class

(Students need to have a set of colored pencils or crayons to keep at home.)

### 1<sup>st</sup> Grade

Lunch box with name on outside

Backpack with name on outside

(Students need to have an extra set of colored pencils or crayons to keep at home.)

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade

New International Version Bible (can be purchased on-line or at Borders—please bring first day of school)
